



#### STEPS FOR THE ABSTRACT FIGURE SCULPTURE:

• SELECT MEDIUM

(Plaster may not have any extended arms/legs)


- FIND IMAGE OF PERSON IN POSE
- SKETCH SIMPLIFICATION FRONT, SIDE, & BACK

## **STEP 1**: FIND AN IMAGE OF THE FIGURE(S) YOU PLAN TO MODEL AFTER



**STEP 2**: DRAW A STICK FIGURE USING BASIC LINES AND SHAPES **STEP 3**: TRANSFORM THE STICK FIGURE DRAWING IN TO YOUR SCULPTURE IDEA






# OPTION 2: 2D to 3D

#### STEPS FOR THE 2D – 3D PROJECT:

- FIND IMAGE
- SCULPT 3D PORTION OF THE IMAGE
- DRY & FIRE QUICKLY
- TRACE BASE OF SCULPTURE TO BOARD

- DRAW/PAINT REALISTICALLY

# OPTION 3: EXPRESSIVE HAND

## • EARTHENWARE CLAY HAND SCULPTURE

 Your sculpture project must primarily consist of a life-sized hand created using ceramic clay. The hand must express some type of character, emotion, or reaction. You may include a small object (real or sculpted) with the hand, but the object may not become the primary focus of the sculpture.
